

## **Registration Procedure – *For the Love of English***

Here are the registration steps for this fun and challenging language training program:

1. Students are asked to provide the following information to Collège Acadie :
  - Name
  - E-mail address
  - Telephone number
  - Time availabilities (local and Atlantic time)
  - Acces to Skype (Y/N)

Following this initial registration process, LRDG will provide the learner with the registration link ([www.lrdgportal.com](http://www.lrdgportal.com)) by e-mail.

2. The learner will be asked to fill out an online Portal Registration Form. Learners have 3 days to register, after which LRDG will contact them to invite them to register on the LRDG Portal. Upon registration, learners will choose a preferred and an alternate time for their oral assessment.
3. The learner will receive a second email from [admin@lrdgportal.com](mailto:admin@lrdgportal.com) informing them that they have successfully signed up and that they can view their student profile on the LRDG Portal located at [www.lrdgportal.com](http://www.lrdgportal.com). The learner will be contacted by LRDG to set up an oral assessment with one of their evaluators if they are not identified as an absolute beginner. The learner should schedule the assessment within 2 days. The time identified on the Portal is for EST time zone, unless otherwise indicated.
4. Once the oral assessment is completed, LRDG will communicate to the student which module level they will be assigned.
